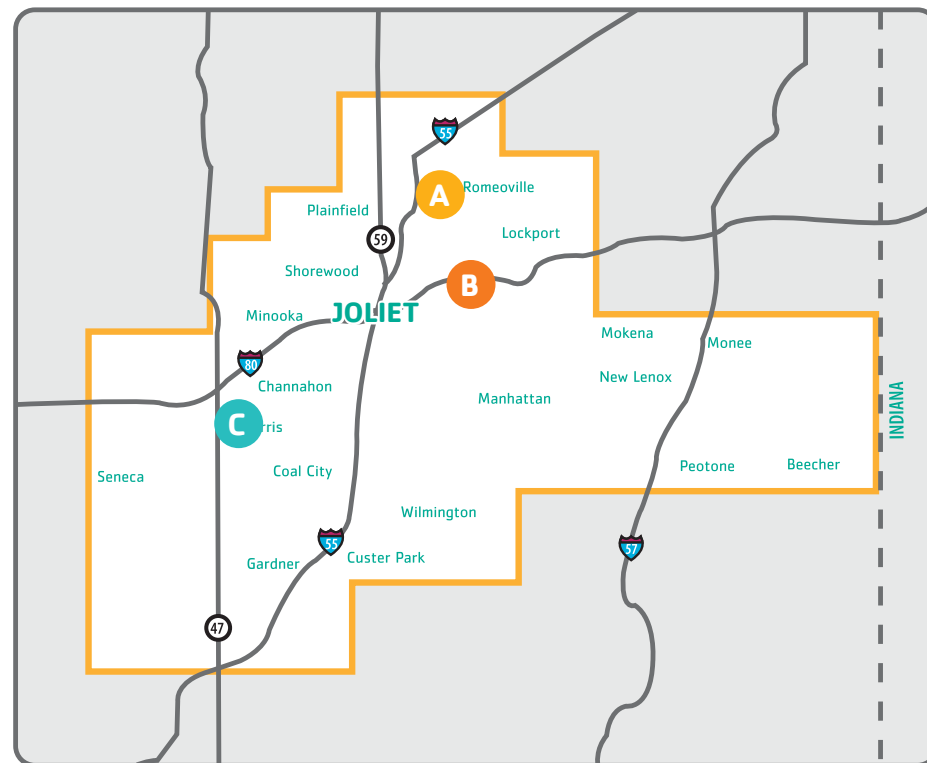
ABOUT THE GREATER JOLIET AREA YMCA
